- Must be female
- Must be living in the Tracy/Mountain House area and an attending senior at one of the following High Schools:
 - Tracy High School
 - West High School
 - Kimball High School
 - Mountain House High School
 - Millennium High School
 - Delta Charter High School
 - Stein High School
 - ONE School
 - Willow High School
- Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Must plan to attend a University, Community College, State College and/or Vocational school upon completion of High School Graduation
- Must submit the following elements:
 - Completed application
 - A transcript for the current school year signed by a school counselor/administrator
 - One letter of recommendation from an educator at your school
 - One letter of recommendation from a personal or work related acquaintance (non family member)
 - A personalized project relating to your career choice
 - Projects can include, but are not limited to:
 - A written essay
 - Multi media project
 - Artwork
 - Or combination of works
